### Project objectives:

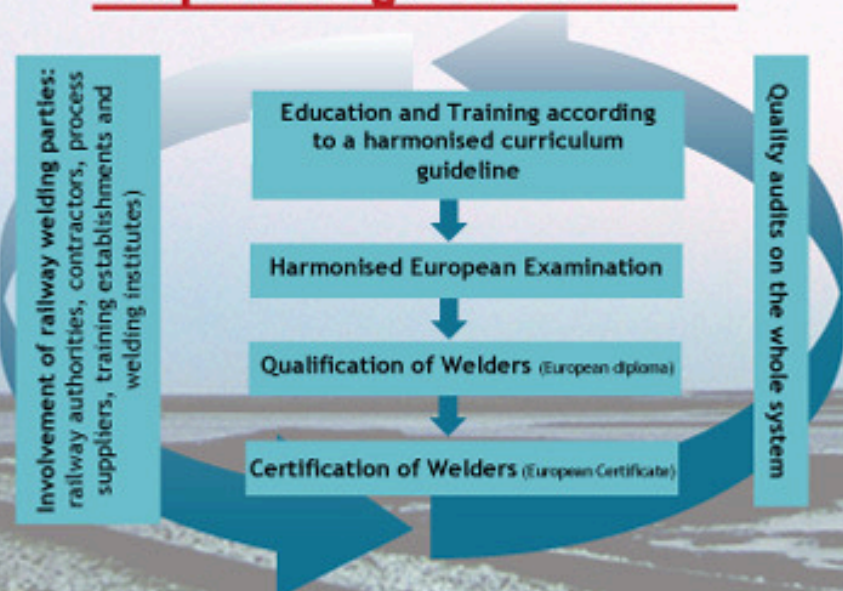
To harmonise education, qualification and certification making exchange of welders from national railway authorities and companies possible in the European Union
