Guideline for training, qualification and certification of arc welders for joining, repairing and refurbishing rails, and rules for its implementation

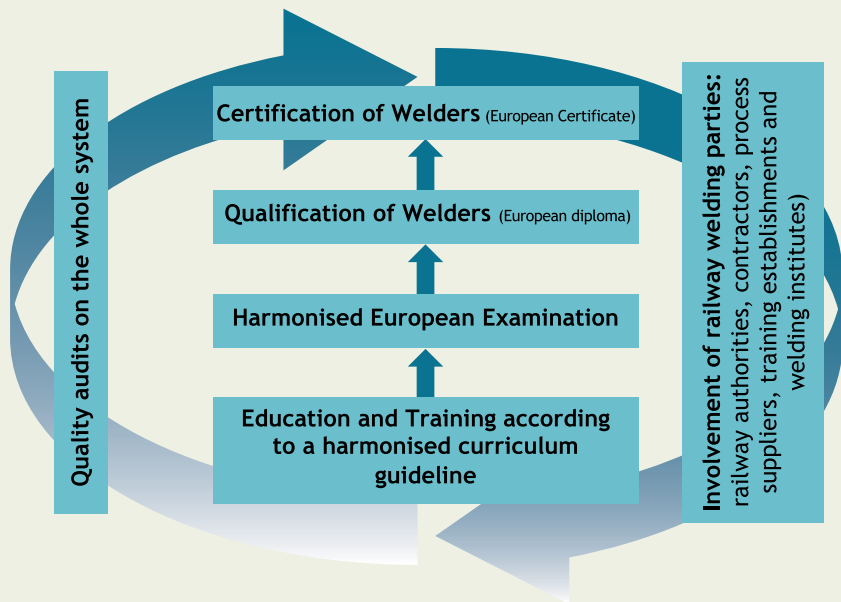
